

ECIV 303 Presentations

The presentations are team presentations concerning a particular material, production, testing or design method. The final product is the power point file you submit to me and the presentation you give to your classmates.

The presentation should be approached from the view that the reader is one of you classmates who wants to know more about the topic you have chosen. It is better to limit your scope of discussion and address it completely than to superficially move from one topic to the next. You are saving your classmates the time and energy by doing work for them, not presenting a summary of information from the internet or Wiki.

I will grade you on the following criteria:

1. How well I think you understand your subject
2. How clearly you explain your topic, verbally, visually and in text form.
3. How coherent your contribution is with your team with regards to the topic.

Your grade will consist of a "team grade" and an "individual" grade, each 50%.

Every one of you will hand in three things, your presentation (one per team) and your personal summary of your contribution to the project (one per student), and your ratings and comments on the other presentations.

Percentage breakdown as follows

Team grade = 50%

Individual grade = 25%

Attendance and rating of presentations = 25%

Your ratings should consist of a value from 0 to 10 (10 is best) of the presentation and a paragraph on your impression of the presentations. You may ask questions following the presentations as well. (Mike Fernandez, you are limited to 3 questions total...just kidding :)
