TO REGISTER: Portland Cement Concrete certification course now has two levels of certification:

Level 1 (Batching) is for ready-mix concrete batch technicians.

Levels 1 and 2 (Inspection) are for technicians and inspectors from SCDOT and consulting Engineering Firms.

A Concrete Technician Certification Experience Form is *required* for all applicants for SCDoT QC/QA Portland Cement Concrete Technician Certification. Please note that **certification will not be granted** as a SCDoT QC/QA Portland Cement Concrete Field Technician without *current* ACI or MTC certification as a Field Testing Technician—Grade I. If the applicant is not certified at the time of the SCDoT examination, they are required to obtain certification **within one year** from the date of successful completion of the SCDoT written examination held at USC **and** provide proof of certification to our offices. This is only a review class and written examination; **applicants must follow the same procedures to renew certification**. Retests are offered on dates apart from the regular review classes. These dates are available only to those who have attended and failed a review class and examination within six months.

Registration cannot be guaranteed until payment and all paperwork have been received by our office. Substitutions may be made at a minimum of three business days prior to the scheduled class. Funds transfers and refunds are only available prior to the deadline set for a scheduled class as posted on our website. Fees must be submitted by **check** or **money order**, payable to the **University of South Carolina**, and sent to:
