RULES: Papers are not to exceed 2,500 words in length, must be written by only one person, and include a complete bibliography. Papers must be written by undergraduate students only. Papers should not have appeared in any publications other than in school or chapter/club publications.

Format of the papers must conform to the official *ASCE Authors' Guide to Journals, Books, and Reference Publications* except as noted in these rules. Entries for the contest shall be limited to one paper from each Student Chapter and must be submitted through the ASCE Faculty Advisor. Authors must be ASCE national student members in good standing at the time of submission to be considered. Entries should include a cover letter from the Faculty Advisor of the Student Chapter, stating the name, ASCE ID number, mailing address, phone, and e-mail of the paper's author. **Send entries to: smithpb@engr.sc.edu. Entries must be received by March 25, 2005.**

The author of each technical paper will be required to present a 'summary presentation' of each technical paper before the judge's panel on the morning of April 9, 2005. The summary presentation is not to exceed 10 minutes in length.
